## Mission/Vision

The Baltimore Station is an innovative, therapeutic residential and outpatient treatment program that supports veterans who are overcoming obstacles to regain self-sufficiency. Men who participate in the program graduate with permanent housing, sustainable income and the tools they need to lead a substance-free life. The program is renowned for its ability to turn lives around for over 34 years and is highly effective in helping veterans to rebuild their lives.

## Turning Lives Around

Funding from the RCM&D Regatta will support The Baltimore Station's annual outdoor education program at Camp Puh Tok. This includes counseling, daily program requirements and outdoor activities like rock climbing, horseback riding and fishing. Clients participate in volunteering at the camp, meal preparation, and experience the benefits of outdoor recreation to those in recovery like stress reduction, relaxation and improved mental health.

## Mission/Vision

Elk Hill provides mental health and academic services to at-risk youth and their families, helping them overcome challenges and achieve success. Their core program is a community and school-based mental health initiative, recognizing that emotional and behavioral problems caused by trauma can hinder academic and social development. Elk Hill aims to help children address these issues to achieve fulfilling and productive lives.

## Breaking Barriers

Funding from the RCM&D Regatta will benefit Elk Hill's youth mental health programs, providing counseling, group therapy, in-home services and therapeutic equine therapy to underprivileged children. This program benefits children without Medicaid or private insurance or those who have exhausted their funding resources. Mental health professionals provide direct care services and support for families and teachers.

## Mission/Vision

Horizon Day Camp is a proud member of the Sunrise Day Camps Association. Horizon Day Camp is based in Baltimore and serves Maryland area children from Baltimore to Washington.

## Every Kid Counts

Funding from the RCM&D Regatta will play a key role in sending more than 160 children impacted by cancer to camp, where they can enjoy a safe environment filled with excitement, friendship and adventure. Since 2015, Horizon Day Camp has provided 7 weeks of summer camp with before and after-care, and year-round recreational programming for children with cancer and their siblings. Horizon Day Camp relies on donations to offer free services, including transportation, and directly funds facility rental, program supplies, 50 summer staff, nurses and counselors, and special events that make up a magical summer!
